Show limited to 1973 and older vehicles

The registration fee is \$45.00 for one vehicle, two people and participant children under the age of 12 with 2 tickets for the Seafood Barbeque. Entry with extra adults or children over the age of 12 who will be coming with you will be \$10.00 each. If your extra adults or children over the age of 12 would like Seafood Barbeque and entry it will be \$20.00 each (\$10.00 Entry + \$10.00 Seafood Barbeque). Your \$45.00 entry fee entitles you to Continental Breakfast Saturday morning, Door Prizes, participation in the Poker Run, Trophies, Show and Shine and BBQ on Sunday.

August 1st is the last day to preorder PARTICIPANT SWEATSHIRTS, NO ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE. ORDERS MUST BE RECEIVED BY AUGUST 1ST. After this date we will just take orders for t-shirts and hats.

This is a two day event and, therefore, a one day registration fee is not available, but you can attend the event for just one day if you choose. If you provide an email address, your confirmation will be emailed to you.

We strongly encourage pre-registration and early motel booking! The Registration and T-Shirt booths will be open on Friday, September 9th from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for pre-registered participants to pick up their packets and pre-paid shirts and shirt sales. On Friday, 8 a.m. you can find the spot you want on the field, but remember your day tents or canopies will be allowed only behind your car **not beside** your car. You are allowed 11' x 20' for your car and day tents. **Remember to bring your own stakes and ribbons to mark your spot.**

As with all events, we have some guidelines we need you to follow to help us put on another great show:

- No alcohol on the grounds
- **PARTICIPANT'S PETS WILL BE ALLOWED BUT MUST BE KEPT IN THE AREA OF THEIR CAR AT ALL TIMES. SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BRING IN PETS, UNLESS IT IS A SERVICE ANIMAL.**
- Space is allowed for registered cars only
- Only day tents or canopies will be allowed behind registered cars
- No bicycles or motorcycles on the field

A couple of new things this year, the first, we are going to have a model car show. If you would like to enter a model car we have the forms on our internet site. (See address below) Second, we are having the Boy Scouts bring their Pinewood Derby cars and race track to race participants cars. So bring your car that you made as a boy scout or as a Den Mother.
